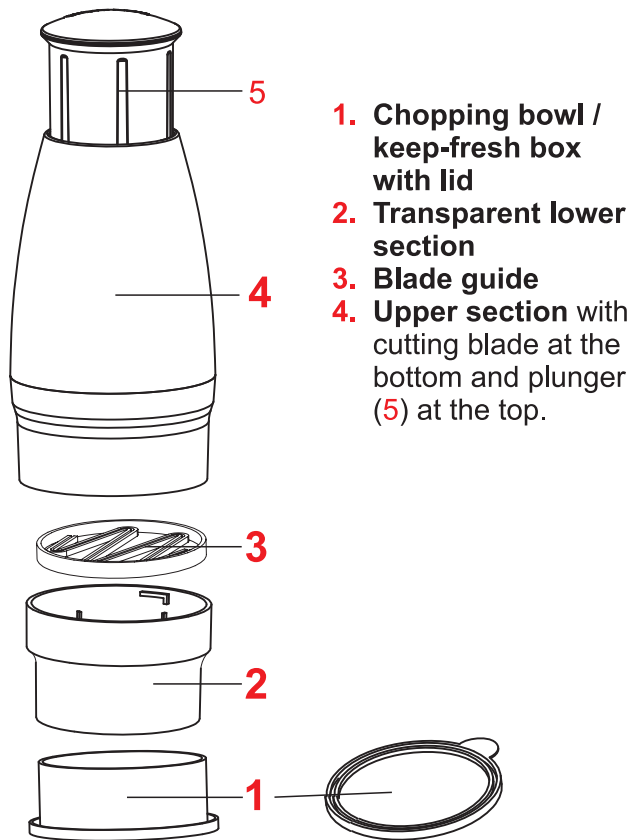


# All-purpose chopper CHOP-CHOP

## Instructions

### Assembly

The "CHOP-CHOP" all-purpose chopper consists of only 4 components (see figure):



### Initial operation

We recommend that you clean the "CHOP-CHOP" before using it for the first time. You can disassemble it for this purpose in just a few steps.

### Disassembly

The following 4 steps are required:

1. Remove the chopping bowl (1) from the "CHOP-CHOP".
2. Place the all-purpose chopper on the work surface.
3. Hold the housing and turn the upper section (4) anti-clockwise to the limit stop. Remove by pulling upwards.
4. Turn the upper section (4) so that the blade faces upwards. CAUTION! Please be careful, as the blade is sharp! Carefully remove the blade guide (3) from the upper section.

### Cleaning

Once the "CHOP-CHOP" has been disassembled, you can clean all the parts. We recommend using running water and a brush.

Where necessary, detergent can also be used. The upper section with the blade should be cleaned under running water, using a brush only! After cleaning, the upper section should be dried with the blade facing downwards. Please do not use a cloth to dry the blade, as this poses a high risk of injury!

### Operation

1. Fill the chopping bowl with onions or vegetables and replace the upper section.
2. Place the complete all-purpose chopper onto a level work surface.
3. Hold the "CHOP-CHOP" with one hand while pressing down (knocking) evenly with the other, open hand.
4. The cutting device will be automatically retracted.
5. During this process, the blades will automatically turn.

**Please note:** When processing larger amounts, you may want to use a cutting board instead of the chopping bowl to divide the food into suitable portions. For quick and efficient results, clean the chopper immediately after use.

### General safety instructions

The all-purpose chopper is not a toy and must be handled with the necessary care.

**Please keep the chopper away from children!**
